

Rules of procedure

You have chosen the camping des Bruyères for your stay and we thank you. The purpose of this regulation is to facilitate the practice of camping, to ensure hygiene and cleanliness, to ensure the general order and the tranquility of each. In advance we wish you a good stay among us.

The campsite LES BRUYERES is subject to the provisions of the decree of 06 July 2010 setting the standards and procedure for the classification of camping-caravanning sites and its decree of 17 February 2014.

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

Article 1

The ground is directed by Chantal and Patrick who have the duty to make respect the order and the tranquility and to cash the regulation of the stay. The mere fact of staying in the campsite entails the tacit acceptance of this by-law and its rate. In his own interest each camper will therefore want to comply with the provisions provided below and comply with instructions from management.

ENTRY FORMALITIES:

Article 2

The campsite Les Bruyères is open only to campers without distinction to the extent of the available space. Young people under 18 years are accepted only if they are accompanied by an adult who can answer for their actions or carriers written authorization from their legal representative.

Local police regulations are strictly enforced. Each camper must, upon arrival, announce at the reception, deposit an ID (membership card, international camping card, ID card, passport, etc.).

Visitors are allowed only after presentation at the reception, their vehicle parked outside the campsite.

Reception is open at the times indicated on the notice board.

1 night is calculated based on arrival from 12.00 am and departure before 12.00 am.

The payment of the stay is imperatively the day before the departure before 8.00 pm for the sites not reserved in advance.

For rental (chalets, bungalows) and spaces reserved in advance, this Payment is on arrival and will not be refunded.

Taxes:

Article 3

The prices indicated are valid for the season in force. They correspond to a night and are quoted in Euros, including TVA.

The amount of the tourist tax is fixed and collected by the community of commune.

CHOICE OF LOCATION:

Article 4

As a general rule, and to the extent possible, campers will be able to choose their location on the spot according to the pitches proposed by the campsite manager. No one can claim a fixed location without reservation.

INSTALLATIONS:

Article 5

The term "installation" covers indiscriminately a tent, a caravan, a camper. Any rental of a private caravan on the ground will be the subject of a specific contract with the campsite. The installation of a caravan in the season will be the subject of a specific contract,

The camper is entitled to occupy only the area assigned to it. The wheels of caravans must not be dismantled.

Fences of all kinds, changes in the nature of the soil, landscaping of gardens and all other fixed installations are prohibited.

Linen drying will be done at common dryers. However, it is tolerated near the accommodation, on the condition that it is discreet and does not bother the neighbors. It should never be done from trees.

Channels can be dug only with the express permission of the manager and according to his instructions. They must be filled before departure.

UNOCCUPIED INSTALLATIONS:

Article 6

The parking of uninhabited facilities is only permitted with the agreement of management on designated locations and against payment.

HYGIENE AND CLEANLINESS:

Article 7

The entire campsite and more particularly the sanitary facilities must be kept clean at all times. Please respect the work of the cleaning staff, leaving as clean sanitary as you would have liked to find them.

It is strictly forbidden to throw litter of any kind containers.

It is also forbidden to dump wastewater on the ground.

Sewage and the contents of portable toilets must be dumped into the waste bin provided for this purpose. Waste must be bagged and placed in waste containers.

Thank you to respect the sorting of waste.

Waste containers, plastic containers and glass containers are available on the site of the campsite. You are requested to use it and keep your location clean and where the containers are installed.

Any washing or cleaning of vehicles and animals in any form is forbidden.

DAMAGE:

Article 8

Campers and visitors are answerable for any damage caused voluntarily or by negligence. Precious objects can be left at the reception.

The liability extends in particular to any damage resulting from the violation of the regulations. The management will not be responsible for any theft, loss or damage that may be caused to those who stay in the campsite or who are there for any reason. The damage caused in case of force majeure will be borne by the camper.

The use of equipment and facilities, made available can not, under any circumstances, engage the responsibility of the campsite manager.

Anyone caught stealing; damaging, vandalizing, as well as troublemakers will be immediately expelled from the campsite.

FIRE:

Article 9

Outdoor open fires and campfires are strictly forbidden. The greatest precautions must be observed to avoid the risk of fire. Electric barbecues are recommended, those charcoal are tolerated in respect of the location and neighborhood (charcoal in bags)

In case of fire, notify the management immediately. Fire extinguishers can be used if necessary. A first aid kit is located at the reception desk.

ELECTRICAL OUTLET:

Article 10

Campers can not claim a fee on an electrical connection.

A parcel with electricity will be allocated in priority to an installation that makes use of it. The LES BRUYERES campsite has undergone a check of the new electrical standards imposed on the campsite and declines all responsibility in the event of an accident caused by defective or inadequate equipment. Connecting cords for unoccupied installations will be disconnected and stored to facilitate ground maintenance.

MEASURES OF ORDER AND TRANQUILITY:

Article 11

Campsite users are urged to avoid all noises, music or discussions that could embarrass their neighbors. The sound devices must be set so as not to be audible outside the tent or caravan. The doors of the boxes and vehicles must be closed as discreetly as possible.

From 10.30 pm to 07.30 am reign nocturnal tranquility. No activity causing noise is not tolerated during this time. Management has the right to postpone land after warning, any person who behaves unbecomingly.

CIRCULATION OF VEHICLES:

Article 12

Vehicle traffic is limited to what is strictly necessary and at a maximum speed of 5 km / h.

During the quiet night, all traffic is prohibited in the enclosure of camping. Guests staying at the campsite returning after 10.30 pm must leave their vehicle outside the campsite.

GAMES:

Article 13

The playground is reserved for the children of the campers. A regulation of respect, of general order and of hygiene will however have to be respected.

No violent or awkward play can be organized near the facilities. The friendship room can not be used for hectic games.

Children must always be under the supervision of their parents.

DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

Article 14

Dogs and cats are allowed in the campsite only on condition that they are calm, tattooed and vaccinated and must be constantly monitored so that they do not disturb the other campers or dirty the facilities or the grounds. It is not allowed to leave animals unattended at the campsite, even locked up, in the absence of their master who are civilly responsible. They must be constantly kept on a short leash, their vaccination record will be requested at the reception to list all the animals present on the campsite. On arrival, you must present the pallet to collect the excrement. It is

mandatory to take them outside the campsite to do their daily needs that must be picked up.

In case of non-observance of these prescriptions, the owner, after warning of the direction, will have to leave the ground. In addition, he will be held responsible for any inconvenience that may result from their behavior.

DEAD GARAGE:

Article 15

It can not be left unoccupied equipment on the ground, only after agreement of the direction and only with the indicated location. This benefit can be paid.
